**RE:** BRIND'AMOUR JERSEY ACQUISITION – STRATHCONA GARDENS

### **PURPOSE/PROBLEM**

To consider a recommendation from the Strathcona Gardens Commission that the Regional District enter into an arrangement to take ownership of a game-worn Rod Brind'Amour jersey in exchange for a tax receipt for the current owner of the jersey.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

At its November 6, 2019 meeting the Strathcona Gardens Commission considered the matter of a possible donation of a hockey jersey worn by Rod Brind'Amour in the 2006 Stanley Cup championship game. The Commission then passed the following motion:

Babchuk/Evans: SGC 98/19

THAT the Strathcona Regional District move forward with an agreement to accept the donation and that we commit up to \$1,000 for an appraisal to determine fair market value.

It is staff's understanding that the intent of the motion is to advise the current owner that the Regional District is prepared to accept ownership of the jersey in exchange for a tax receipt to be issued once a fair market appraisal is done. The Regional District would pay for the appraisal as part of its legal obligations under the proposed transfer agreement.

The actions outlined below are offered in support of the Commission's recommendation.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

1. THAT the report from the Chief Administrative Officer be received.
2. THAT the Regional District move forward with an agreement to accept the donation of a game-worn Rod Brind'Amour hockey jersey, and

THAT up to \$1,000 be committed for an appraisal to determine fair market value.
